Categories include:

1. Mild Chili
2. Chili with a little bit of heat
3. Chili - flame thrower hot

Rules:

1. This event is FREE to enter.
2. Minimum of 6 quarts must be supplied & served from a non-commercial crock pot.
3. Entries must supply & post an ingredient list (no portions required) & highlight potential food allergies.
4. Chili's will be numbered with no names, logos or other identification allowed.
5. Food Judges will choose the Top 3 Chili's based on a structured evaluation point system.
6. The public will be able to buy sample tokens (samples are 1 cup of chili each) at a rate of 3 samples for \$5. These sample tokens will be tabulated to identify the Public Choice Award.
7. Logging Days will supply the sides including garlic bread & salad.
8. Entries must be submitted by September 19, 2017.



Judging will take place as part of Logging Days 2017 on Saturday September 23 with registration & set-up from 5:00-6:00pm, serving from 6:00-7:00pm and Winners to be announced at 7:30pm.

Entry fees for each category will be used for the prize money and distributed as follows:

1 st Place	15% of the entry fees for the category
2 nd Place	10% of the entry fees for the category
3 rd Place	5% of the entry fees for the category
Public Choice Award	Cash prize & certificate
